DROP-OFF & PICK-UP PROCEDURES

DROP-OFF AT STAGE-DOOR ENTRANCE

950 Francis Street Houston, TX 77002

Performers must enter at the stage door for sign-in. The theater prohibits performers from entering through the front. On the day of the show, arrive IN COSTUME WITH HAIR AND MAKEUP DONE. Carry ballet shoes in hand. DO NOT WEAR BALLET SHOES OUTSIDE.

<u>PICK-UP:</u> After the recital has concluded, performers will be released from the stage.

NO PARENTS ARE ALLOWED BACKSTAGE. Students will be under the supervision of our trusted staff and volunteers. We want you to enjoy the recital from the audience! Our staff will take care of costume changes and backstage arrangements.

COSTUMES, HAIR & MAKEUP:

You provide: Performance shoes and makeup.

Ladies in **Foundations, **Level A**, **and Level B** should also obtain a "nude" leotard. The nude leotards act as undergarments, worn underneath costumes to guard against any costume 'malfunctions' and to make costume changes easier. No nude leotards with clear straps.

We provide: costumes & headpieces, and tights.

Costumes will be distributed on Saturday May 13th after studio rehearsal.

Hair details:

<u>Ladies</u>: Hair is to be worn in a classical bun at the crown of the head. Hair must be slicked back and hair sprayed into place. NO FLY AWAYS. Makeup is required to keep performers from looking washed out under the stage lights. Please highlight features of the eyes, cheek bones, and lips. To keep the makeup looking age appropriate, we recommend using the following: blush, mascara, a light brown eyeshadow, and a slightly darker than skin tone lipstick or lip liner. A subtle foundation or translucent powder can be used to remove shine as needed.

<u>Gentlemen</u>: Hair must be neatly styled out of the face. <u>Light</u> makeup should include eye liner, blush, and lipstick.

Miscellaneous:

Dancers should plan to stay the whole time in the theater. They may not leave during their break time, and should therefore pack a snack, water, and perhaps a book or game. Please bring a non-messy snack, i.e. crackers, carrot sticks (no dressing), or granola bars.

We will have coloring activities for the young ones. **DO NOT BRING ANY VALUABLES**. Bayou City Ballet and the MATCH Theater are not responsible for lost or damaged items.
