

2024-2025 Registration Information and Policies

You are enrolling in a year-round training program, August through May.

All tuition and fees are non-refundable.

A 30-day notice is required if withdrawing in order to remove any future charges. Tuition can be paid by credit card, check, or cash.

Payment of Tuition

Pricing includes class tuition, annual registration fee, and Spring Showcase fees (performance costume/tights, digital recording).

Tuition is split into installments for your convenience. Full payment up front offers a discount of \$100.

The installment plan requires you keep an up-to-date credit card on file.

The first installment is due at the time of

registration, with the remaining installments due on the 1st of each designated month as follows: Children's Program: Aug, Oct, Dec, Feb; Pre-Professional Program: Aug, Sep, Oct, Nov, Dec, Feb, Mar.

Past Due Accounts

A late fee of \$35 will be applied to accounts past due more than 5 days.

There is a \$35 fee for all returned checks.

Any student whose account is more than 14 days past due will not be permitted to attend class until payment is made.

Refer a student and get a \$50 credit when they give your name upon enrollment!

Dress Code

Dress code will be strictly enforced for students in Children's and Pre-Professional programs. Following a grace period of two weeks, students not in proper attire may be asked to watch class. A detailed list will be provided and can be found on our website.

Studio Expectations

Be on time for class. The beginning of class is the most important time and is crucial to avoid injuries. *Students arriving more than ten minutes after the start of class will be asked to watch the class.*

Missed Classes

If you miss a scheduled class, it may be made up by attending a class of a similar level (by appointment only, based on availability). Students are permitted up to two make-up classes per semester.

Creative Movement (Age 3-4) One class per week *Studio Presentation instead of Spring Showcase 5 installments: \$160

> Joy of Dance (Age 4-5) One class per week 5 installments: \$185

Pre-Ballet (Age 5-6) & Primary 1 (Ages 6-7) One class per week 5 installments: \$260

Primary 2 (Age 7-8) *Two classes per week* 5 installments: \$400

Foundations 1 (minimum age 8) *Two classes per week* 5 installments: \$520

> Foundations 2 Three classes per week 5 installments: \$680

Pre-Professional Program

Audition or Placement Class Required Level is at sole discretion of the Artistic Director

> Level A1 4 classes per week 8 installments: \$550

Level A2 5 classes per week 8 installments: \$600

Level B 6 classes per week 8 installments: \$650

Level C 7 classes per week 8 installments: \$700
