

2023-2024 Registration Information and Policies

You are enrolling in a year-round training program, August through May.

All tuition and fees are non-refundable.

If you withdraw from the program mid-year, you forfeit any remaining tuition.

Tuition can be paid by credit card, check, or cash.

Payment of Tuition

Pricing includes class tuition, annual registration fee, and Spring Showcase fees (performance costume/tights, digital recording).

Full payment up front offers a discount. Alternatively, tuition may be split into installments for your convenience.

The installment plan requires you keep an up-to-date credit card on file.

The first installment is due at the time of registration, with the remaining installments due on the 1st of each month as follows:
Children's Program: Aug, Oct, Dec, Feb;
Pre-Professional Program: Aug, Sep, Oct, Nov,

Dec, Feb, Mar.

Past Due Accounts

A late fee of \$35 will be applied to accounts past due more than 5 days.

There is a \$35 fee for all returned checks. Any student whose account is more than 14 days past due will not be permitted to attend class until payment is made. Refer a student and get a \$50 credit when they give your name upon enrollment!

Dress Code

Be on time for class. The beginning of class is the most important time and is crucial to avoid injuries. Students arriving more than ten minutes after the start of class will be asked to watch the class.

Missed Classes

If you miss a scheduled class, it may be made up by attending a class at the same level or lower (by appointment only, based on availability). Students are permitted up to two make-up classes per semester.
